

Snowflake Moray Eel

Hardy Marine Fish

The Snowflake Moray Eel is a tropical marine fish, that is hardy, and not extremely fussy about water conditions.

Water Parameters

pH of 8.2

Seawater or artificial seawater with a Specific Gravity of 1.020—1.026

Temperature Range

Temp 24 °C - 27°C

Size

Snowflake Moray's can grow to a size of 75cm.

Feeding

Snowflake Morays are predators and require meaty foods such as fresh and frozen fish, crustacean flesh and krill, using a feeding stick. Adult Snowflakes only require feeding 2—3 times per week, juveniles need more frequent feeding.

Temperament

They are peaceful towards tank mates that they don't see as a potential meal. They can be very aggressive during feeding time and have been known to latch on to other fish during the feeding frenzy.

Housing

Because of the size to which they can grow, they require a minimum tank size of 120 litres.

Snowflake Morays can be kept with other Morays, and are considered to be the most outgoing moray as they are commonly seen swimming out in the open. You should provide them with rocky lairs in which to hide and they will settle quickly into aquarium life.

As with other Eels, a tight fitting lid is essential to prevent them from escaping.

They also need powerful filtration because they are messy eaters and produce a lot of waste.
