

Glassfish Olive

Ambassis agassizii



Natural Range

This **Australian Native** used to be found quite commonly in Victoria, New South Wales and Queensland. In recent years they have suffered a decline in numbers. Wild populations of olive glassfish are now only found in a few sites in the Darling River system.

The fish commercially available now have been cultured on farms.

Maximum Size and Appearance

The Olive Glassfish is a deep-bodied semi-transparent fish with very large eyes and dark edge scales. They can grow to about 7.5cm.

Water Quality

- Temperature: 15°C 28°C.
- pH: 7.0
- · General Hardness: 150—220 ppm.

Compatibility

Olive glassfish should be kept as a small school and should not be mixed with large or aggressive species.
