Planting Instructions (Boxed Al Naturals Plant)

- Take the plants from the bag
- Carefully remove all the jelly by washing under a tap
- Individually plant into substrate, taking care to only bury the roots

General Information

Baby Tears have a small green leaf which contrasts well with dark foliage. It is ideal for both community aquariums and paludariums (half aquarium, half terrarium).

In an aquarium, it looks best when grown in a bunch, and planted in a terrace formation. In a pond, it will grow around the edges and beyond the water surface, and flower in the summer with small white or pink flowers.

Baby Tears is undemanding. It tolerates varied water conditions, and can tolerate cooler conditions in an unheated room for short periods. Take care during warmers months, as it does not tolerate extreme heat. For useful tips on steps to take during warmer weather, see the Aquarium Industries "Hot Weather Tips" Care Sheet.

Once established, it can be propagated through cuttings.
