# Planting Instructions (Boxed Al Naturals Plant)

- Take the plants from the bag
- Carefully remove all the jelly by washing under a tap
- Individually plant into substrate, taking care to only bury the roots

#### **General Information**

Bacopa is a versatile plant which is suited to a range of uses. It is ideal for both aquariums and paludariums (half aquarium, half terrarium). It is also well suited to ponds, where it will grow around the edges and beyond the water surface, developing flowers in summer.

Featuring a thick stem which grows straight, it looks best when planted in bunches, in a terrace formation.

While Bacopa will tolerate cool temperatures for short periods of time, take care during warmer weather, as it does not like high temperatures for extended periods of time. For useful tips on steps to take during warmer weather, see the Aquarium Industries "Hot Weather Tips" Care Sheet.

To get the best from this plant, ensure that lighting is adequate. Once established, it propagates through cuttings.
